

Immunization of School Pupils Act (ISPA) Vaccination 2023-2024:

Preparation for Suspension

This document includes resources and prepared messages that elementary schools can use to communicate the ISPA-based vaccination enforcement plans for elementary students in the 2023-2024 school year. Messaging and information to prepare for the March 1, 2024 suspension day is also included (see suspension day notes below). Schools may also choose to send out these messages directly to families that have received a suspension notice and/or to those families with children suspended from school on March 1, 2024.

- WECHU is hosting School Suspension Prevention Immunization Clinics and prioritizing elementary students who have received a suspension order from the WECHU until February 28, 2024. Clinics are being held at the WECHU's Windsor and Leamington Offices.
- Families are encouraged to book appointment with their health care provider. If that is not
 possible, families can book an appointment at the WECHU, by visiting
 www.wechu.org/getimmunized.
- There will be no clinics on Thursday, February 29, 2024.

- Families have until 6 pm on Wednesday, February 28, 2024 to provide updated immunization records to the WECHU. Immunization records can be submitted to the WECHU by:

Suspension Day Process Notes

- Suspension day is Friday, March 1, 2024. The last day of suspension for elementary school students is April 8, 2024.
- School administrators will have their lists of suspended students by start of school day March 1, 2024.
- Suspended students are not permitted to attend school until their immunization record is updated with the WECHU.
- Starting March 1, 2024, when suspension is in effect parents/guardians cannot update vaccination records over the phone, they must bring the immunization record to the health

unit, have their child's Health Care Provider fax their child's record to the WECHU or update the record online at immune.wechu.org (must upload proof of immunization).

- Once the student's immunization record is updated, the WECHU withdraws the suspension order. The student's name will automatically be removed from the suspension list for the following day.
- To attend school on the same day, families must go to the WECHU to receive a note to be admitted to school.
- The WECHU is hosting suspension walk in clinics starting on Friday, March 1, 2024, from 8:45 am to 3:30 pm. Appointments are not needed. Depending on the volume of students at these clinics, the WECHU may stop taking students earlier than our posted operational hours.
 - Clinic dates and times may change. Families are encouraged to visit www.wechu.org/getimmunized for more information.
- The WECHU will issue a media statement about the number of elementary students suspended and what parents/guardians need to do to get their child back to school. Visit the WECHU newsroom site for more information.

Voicemail or Email Scripts

The following is recommended for use as an email template, pre-recorded phone message/Synervoice, and/or on-hold message at the school or the board office.

For use prior to February 28 @ 6 pm

Good morning / afternoon,

If your child has received a suspension order by mail, you are reminded to make sure they're up to date on their vaccines based on the requirements to attend school in Ontario.

Families should book immunization appointments with their health care provider and notify the Windsor-Essex County Health Unit (WECHU) of their appointment. Report vaccines received from a health care provider to the WECHU at immune.wechu.org.
