




Epidemic Curve by 3-Day Moving Average by Reported Date (Aug to Oct)




Cumulative Cases and Deaths of COVID-19 in WEC




7-Day Moving Average by Reported Date




Windsor-Essex Rate by Reported Week




Weekly COVID-19 Rate




Percent Positivity by Week by All Tests




Percentage of Tests Results Available Within 1 and 2 Days: 7-Day Average










Rate per 100,000 by Municipality












Map of confirmed active COVID-19 cases in Windsor




Age & Sex Distribution




Age & Sex Distribution (August to Present)




Distribution of COVID-19 Cases by Municipality




Distribution of COVID-19 Cases by Municipality in last 30 days (August 31 to September 30)




Distribution of COVID-19 Cases by Municipality in last 7 days (September 24 to September 30)




















Exposure History by Reported Date (Aug to Present)












Age & Sex Breakdown of COVID-19 Deaths




Case Fatality Rate

Summary

- Windsor-Essex is seeing low cases overall.
- The primary source of exposure continues to be close contact with a confirmed case
- COVID-19 related hospitalizations and ICU occupancy is low.
- Day-over-day doubling time in Windsor-Essex is better compared to the province and nationally
- R0 (effective) value is 0.44 indicating a decrease in transmission in Windsor-Essex
