



### Daily new confirmed COVID-19 cases per million people




Shown is the rolling 7-day average. The number of confirmed cases is lower than the number of actual cases; the main reason for that is limited testing.

### Number of COVID-19 patients in hospital per million people



#### Number of COVID-19 patients in intensive care (ICU) per million people







#### SARS-CoV-2 sequences by variant






# Number of Cases in Ontario (Daily New cases and 7-day average)




## **Epidemic Curve by Reported Date in Windsor- Essex**




## Windsor-Essex Rate by Reported Week











## % Positivity in Ontario: 7-Day Average




### % Positivity in Windsor-Essex by Age: 7-Day Average






## Rate per 100,000 by Municipality (August to **Present)**




# Distribution of COVID-19 Cases by Municipality in last 30 days (July 27 to August 25)




# Distribution of COVID-19 Cases by Municipality in last 7 days (August 19 to August 25)

















Total number of people who received at least one vaccine dose, divided by the total population of the country.





#### Share of the population fully vaccinated against COVID-19




Total number of people who received all doses prescribed by the vaccination protocol, divided by the total population of the country.




## Number of Vaccine Doses Administered Daily to Windsor-Essex Residents




### **Daily Doses Administered to Windsor-Essex Residents**




# Daily Doses Administered in Windsor-Essex by Dose (July-Present)




# WEC Residents Vaccinated With At Least One Dose by Age Group




### WEC Residents Fully Vaccinated by Age Group



## First and Second Dose Coverage Rate by Age Group in Windsor-Essex




# Vaccine Coverage in WEC Hotspots With at Least 1 Dose Administered (all residents including children)




# Fully Vaccinated Coverage Rates in Hotspots Within Windsor-Essex County (all residents including children)




# **COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Rates (12+) Versus COVID-19 Cases (7-Day Average)**

## **Summary**

- The case rate in Windsor-Essex County has significantly increased again this week
- Wastewater surveillance indicates a rise in COVID-19 in the region
- COVID-19 related hospitalizations & ICU have increased this week
- First dose vaccination coverage rate for all of WEC is 69.0%, up from 68.4% last week
- Second dose vaccination coverage rate for all of WEC is 62.7%, up from 61.7% last week

## **Summary of Monitoring Indicators for WEC**

- Most recent completed weekly case rate = 87.5 cases/100,000 population
  - Most recent 7-day rate = 86.8 cases/100,000 population
- Percent positivity = 7.5% (full week)
  - Most recent 7-days percent positivity = 7.6%
- R0 (effective) = 1.09
- Outbreaks are increasing in the region
- 79.9% of Windsor-Essex adults with at least 1 dose
- 73.2% of Windsor-Essex adults fully vaccinated
