


## COVID-19 Cases in the World, Ontario, and Windsor-Essex

Shown is the rolling 7-day average. The number of confirmed cases is lower than the number of actual cases; the main reason for that is limited testing.



#### Share of SARS-CoV-2 sequences that are the delta variant






#### Number of COVID-19 patients in hospital per million people






## Number of Cases in Ontario (Daily New cases and 7-day average)




## **Epidemic Curve by Reported Date in Windsor- Essex**




## Windsor-Essex Rate by Reported Week











## % Positivity in Ontario: 7-Day Average




### % Positivity in Windsor-Essex by Age: 7-Day Average






### Rate per 100,000 by Municipality (July to Present)




# Distribution of COVID-19 Cases by Municipality in last 30 days (June 22 to July 21)




# Distribution of COVID-19 Cases by Municipality in last 7 days (July 15 to July 21)

















#### Share of the population fully vaccinated against COVID-19




Share of the total population that have received all doses prescribed by the vaccination protocol. This data is only available for countries which report the breakdown of doses administered by first and second doses.




## Number of Vaccine Doses Administered Daily to Windsor-Essex Residents




### **Daily Doses Administered to Windsor-Essex Residents**




### Daily Doses Administered in Windsor-Essex by Dose




# **Cumulative Doses Administered to Windsor- Essex Residents by Date**




# WEC Residents Vaccinated With At Least One Dose by Age Group




## Percentage of Population With at Least One Dose by Age Group and Week in Windsor-Essex




### WEC Residents Fully Vaccinated by Age Group




# Percentage of Population Fully Vaccinated by Age Group in Windsor-Essex




## First and Second Dose Coverage Rate by Age Group in Windsor-Essex




# Vaccine Coverage in WEC Hotspots With at Least 1 Dose Administered (all residents including children)




First Dose COVID-19 Vaccine Coverage by Forward Sortation Area (FSA) among Windsor and Essex County Residents



# Fully Vaccinated Coverage Rates in Hotspots Within Windsor-Essex County (all residents including children)




#### Second Dose COVID-19 Vaccine Coverage by Forward Sortation Area (FSA) among Windsor and Essex County Residents




## Number of Doses Administered by Vaccine Type to Windsor-Essex Residents




## Number of Doses Administered Daily by Vaccine Type to Windsor-Essex Residents (March to Present)




# **COVID-19 Vaccination Coverage Rates (12+) Versus COVID-19 Cases (7-Day Average)**

## **Summary**

- The case rate in Windsor-Essex County have decreased again this week
- COVID-19 related hospitalizations & ICU remain low
- First dose vaccination coverage rate is 65.7%, up from 65.1% last week
- Second dose vaccination coverage rate is 55.0%, up from 51.6% last week

## **Summary of Monitoring Indicators for WEC**

- Most recent completed weekly case rate = 1.6 cases/100,000 population
  - Most recent 7-day rate = 2.3 cases/100,000 population
- Percent positivity = 0.5% (full week)
  - Most recent 7-days percent positivity = 0.6%
- R0 (effective) = 1.39
- There is 1 active outbreak
- 76.8% of Windsor-Essex adults with at least 1 dose
- 65.7% of Windsor-Essex adults fully vaccinated
