




Food Security in Windsor-Essex

Food Security in Windsor-Essex

- Over 1 in 10 households (10.8%) in Windsor-Essex County are moderately or severely food insecure.
- Nearly 1 in 10 children (9.7%) in Windsor-Essex County are moderately or severely food insecure.
- Over 1 in 4 low-income households (27.4%) in Windsor-Essex County are moderately or severely food insecure.
