

## ADDITIONAL PRECAUTIONS

### DROPLET

Private room or 2 metre separation with curtain pulled

**Staff** - mask and eye protection

**Patient / Resident** - mask if outside room

### CONTACT

Private room or cohort with same (if lab confirmed)

**Staff** - gown and gloves where appropriate

Dedicated equipment

### DROPLET + CONTACT

Combine all elements of both

### AIRBORNE

Negative pressure room with door closed

**Staff** - N95 Respirator where appropriate

**Patient / Resident** - mask if outside room
