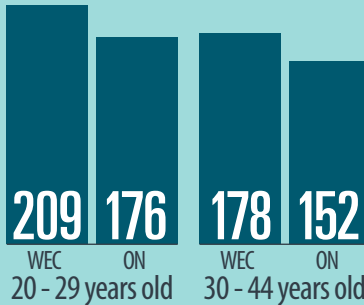


Opioid & Substance Use

WHAT'S HAPPENING IN WINDSOR AND ESSEX COUNTY?

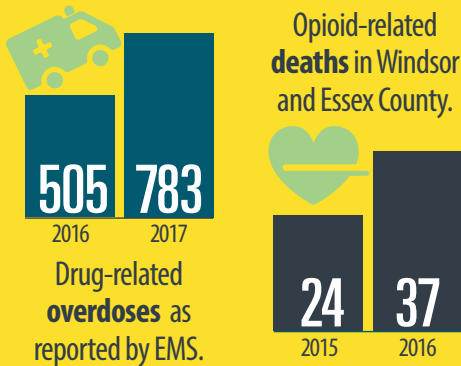
About **1 in 100** people have **injected illicit drugs** in their lifetime.

Emergency department visit rates for **opioid-related overdoses** in 2016 per 100,000 people



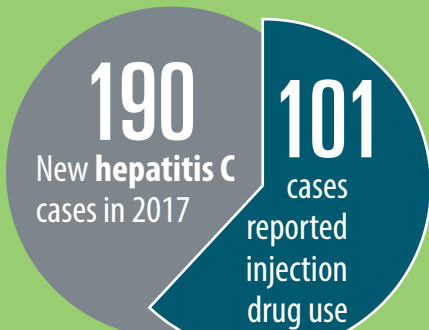
Locally in Windsor and Essex County, we are facing increased illness and deaths related to the use of opioids and other drugs.

Opioids & Methamphetamines are the second and third most common substances identified at emergency department visits in 2017.



3270 naloxone kits, (a medication that reverses opioid-related overdoses) given out between January 2017 and March 2018

Emergency department visits related to methamphetamines has dramatically increased since 2013.



22 of the 190 cases didn't provide detailed information about injection drug use.

Needle-related calls in Windsor **increased significantly**.

43 in 2016

121 in 2017
